Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board Of Commissioners of the Zion Park District Lake County, Illinois Held at the Leisure Center in Said District at 7:00 P.M. On The 19th Day of January, 2012

President McDowell called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and asked for the roll call.
