Park Maintenance

Park and Playground Guidelines

Outdoor recreation guidelines provided by the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) for Phase 4 of the Restore Illinois Plan are listed below.

Visitors should adhere to minimum safety guidelines during their visit to our parks:

- Maintain social distance of 6 feet from individuals outside of your household
- Group sizes should be limited to 10 individuals
- 30 feet of distance should be maintained between groups
- Wear a face covering if social distancing is not possible
- Wash hands often or use hand sanitizer
- Stay home if you are sick
- Sanitize surfaces such as picnic tables and park benches before and after use
- Shelters are available sunrise to sunset, first come first serve, for small picnic gatherings only (no rentals)

No restrooms, electric, or special equipment allowed at shelters

OPEN

- Walking paths and trails
- Picnic tables, park benches and shelters
- Playground equipment
- Basketball courts
- Tennis courts
- Grills
- Fishing

CLOSED

- Drinking fountains
- Restrooms
