## Summer Camp

The Zion Park District will follow guidelines outlined by the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Development (DCEO) during Phase 4 of the Restore Illinois Plan to provide a safe and healthy camp experience for families. Our staff is working diligently to make adaptations to our camps, as well as preparing extensive orientation and training for camp staff.

## Phase 4 Summer Camp Modifications:

### Parent Information:

- Camp will have reduced hours and weeks due to the COVID-19 virus.
- Camp will be from 8:00am-3:00pm, Monday through Friday. All campers must be in attendance by 9:00am.
- Camp will run July 13 to August 21 (6 weeks).
- We will have 3 groups of 10 children maximum. Registration will be done by first come first serve.  
Note: Campers must live in the local area of Zion, Beach Park, Wadsworth or Winthrop Harbor.
- Registration fee is \$135 per week. A non-refundable deposit of \$25.00 for each week is required to reserve the campers spot (this will be applied to the weekly fee). Weekly registration must be paid in full by Friday 3:30pm to attend the following week.
- Upon payment of camp a registration packet will be emailed. Please fill out all forms. An outdoor on-site registration time and day will be scheduled for packets to be dropped off the week before camp begins.
- All Registration paper work must be completed and turned in before the first day of camp.
- According to CDC (Center for Disease Control) no fieldtrips or swimming will be available this summer.

### Camper Drop-Off:

- Campers will be checked in at drop off from their vehicles in the parking lot.
- A Park District camp counselor will be completing a Health Assessment form at time of drop off. Please allow extra time for this process and follow Park District directions when entering and exiting the parking lot.
- Parents will not be able to enter the building at any time.
- Campers will be required to wash hands before entering the classroom.
- If a child is exhibiting any symptoms of the virus they will not be allowed at camp.

### Camper Pick-Up:

- Campers will be outside waiting for pick-up in designated group areas when possible. If weather does not permit outside groups please call 847-746-5500 ext. 2440 for pick up by 3:00pm.

### The following items are needed for camp:

- Disposable lunch & drink every day. We suggest that the lunch should be in disposable containers to discard after use.  
No refrigeration will be available for lunch.
- Water bottle filled with water. (Water fountain will not be in operation during camp)
- Sunscreen (child must apply their own sunscreen) and bug spray. Groups will be outside as much as possible. We recommend that sunscreen be applied before arriving at camp.
- Facemask must be worn when inside and when social distancing cannot occur.
- Comfortable clothes with gym shoes should be worn. Campers should bring an extra set of clothes.
- When appropriate families will be grouped together regardless of age.
- Campers will have assigned areas for storage of personal belongings.
