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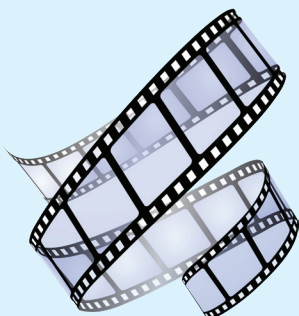
SHOPPERS

FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT TRUST TOURS

Journey back in time to Oak Park, IL. with a guided tour of Frank Lloyd Wright's first home and studio (1889-1909) that was the birthplace of an architectural revolution. Wright used his home to explore design concepts that contained the seeds of his architectural philosophy. In his adjacent studio, Wright and his associates developed a new American architecture – the Prairie style. The historic district surrounding the Home and Studio has the greatest number of Wright-designed residences worldwide. Following lunch at Billy Bricks, there will be a guided tour of Unity Temple (1905-08) Frank Lloyd Wright's only surviving public building from his Prairie period. Limited by a modest budget and an urban site, Wright created an innovative design and used unconventional materials to produce one of the most sophisticated accomplishments of his early career. The oldest Wright building still in use for the same purpose for which it was built, Unity Temple stands today as a masterpiece of modern architecture and design. Fee includes admission to the tours and transportation. ****Large bags and parcels, backpacks, strollers, food, drinks and chewing gum are prohibited in the museums. The Home is not accessible to wheel-chairs of any size as all entries to the Home have stairs. To reach the front door of the Home, guests will need to climb 5 stairs. Once inside the house, to reach the second floor, guests must walk up and then back down a narrow flight of 19 stairs.** No refunds will be given after the registration deadline date.**
